Concept Proposal Guidelines for 2017-2018

1. Research Proposal Title
2. Implementing Agency

4. Significance and Objectives
 - Discuss the background and importance of the problem that the proposed research addresses.
 - Identify the general and specific objectives of the proposed research.
 - Identify the priority research areas and explain how the study addresses these priorities.
5. Strategy and Methodology
 - Describe the methodology to be used to accomplish the objectives of the proposed research. This section includes how data will be collected, analyzed, and interpreted.
 - Describe any strategy to establish feasibility (to complete the proposed research within the proposed period), and address the management of any high risk aspects of the proposed work.
 - Describe clearly the role and functions of all persons involved in the proposed research.
6. Expected Outcomes/Outputs/Deliverables
 - Identify clearly the intended results (i.e., significant and measurable change in condition) and identify the beneficiaries, location, and anticipated benefits they will receive.
 - Describe the specific outputs.
 - Policy recommendations
 - Products (e.g., evaluation instrument)
 - Services (e.g., training program)
 - Processes (e.g., quality assurance mechanism)
 - Systems (e.g., management system for adopting technology)
